Cardboard Boat Regatta

Guest/Castaways are pre-selected and placed in Teams. Attendees are then instructed to name their Team and design a Team Logo. After a 5 minute Team Council to discuss vital strategies, Teams will compete against other, in a series of both mental and physical challenges

(All Physical Challenges are Couch Potato Friendly)

Examples: Foam Pad Relay, Orange Balloon Relay, Walla Ball, Wango Tango, Mummy Wrap, Human Obstacle Course, Frisbee Relay, Mini Scavenger Hunt, Brain Teasers, Trivia and much more.

Teams/Challenges will be rotated until all Teams have competed against each other. For every challenge, a Team wins they win a Victory Token, the object being to gather as many Victory Tokens as possible. The two Teams with the most Victory Tokens compete against each other in one fun-filled final challenge.

You're Hired!

Once Teams are in place each Team will select their Project Leader and The Ronald and his Assistant will lead the Teams through a series of mind bending strategy challenges in which they will be competing against the clock (and each other) before time runs out!

Each Team will be staked \$500 in advance and each challenge will have a different \$ amount attached to it. Teams may buy more time for certain challenges if they wish.

Culminating in the final Challenge:

Sales Pitch - Teams will have 30 minutes to come up with a 4 minute New Product Ad Campaign (A fictitious product we will give them) which will include a Print Ad and TV Commercial. In their presentations they will need to direct their print and TV Commercials. They will be judged on different criteria, including how they were able to incorporate all the members of their Team.

Set-up: Basically, Teams will be sitting together with each team at their own table. They will have the opportunity to purchase items for their presentations with their money, for which they can go to the "supply table" or the "store keeper" can go to them. After designing, and deciding on their final presentation, they will need to draw their print ad on their flip chart, and for their actual presentation to The Ronald, they will need to present it in the best manner they choose. This may be seated or standing, however, so each team is able to see, and enjoy, the other's presentation, they usually stand. Great fun and an amazing team building program!

Boardroom: Each Team must face off with The Ronald and the winning Team will be hired!

NOTE: This program may be offered as a dinner program or as a stand along program.

PIPELINE

Overview:

This program is an interactive team-builder that encourages all to work together within their small teams and also as a team within the larger company.

The Game:

All teams have an 8'x 8' area that are connected to each other in a row. Within that square, each team must utilize the limited supplies given them (e.g., PVC, duct tape, bamboo stakes) to help deliver a small steel ball from one end to the other. Hence, each team's section of the pipeline must interface with the one before and the one after. Often the metaphor of "Delivering the Product to the Customer" is attached to this exciting and brain-teasing activity.

The program lasts about 2 hours and can include a debriefing by our trained facilitator.

Worth, it could have been the "Build-a-Robot" where robot parts were hidden around a conference center. Teams had to determine which parts were needed to develop a product ready for sale, create a marketing plan and present to their peers with parameters of time constraints, budget allowances, and client/vendor communication issues. The point is that this is the most flexible hunt and we can customize the program to your needs.

Groups crack codes, solve riddles and complete mini missions using their innate abilities and individual skills to combine with the high tech challenges of the Global Positioning System, cell phones, digital cameras, maps, and hidden clues. Customized for your group's goals, the GPS Scaventure will challenge creativity, intelligence, communication, and newly acquired skills while having fun.

This program can be done outdoors at a resort, in a city, at a conference center...anywhere on Earth!

HAIR-RAISING RACE

The Game

Inspired by the popular TV show "Amazing Race," this fast-paced team building event challenges teams to navigate a series of 'detours' and 'roadblocks' as they race to complete the circuit. This involves solving clues, collecting bonus items and completing humorous team tasks along the way; all with healthy doses of laughter thrown in.

Highly customizable, Hair-Raising Race works well with forms of Transportation; ranging from public transport, trolley, or chauffeured Limousine, to participants' own feet. We all want to make a difference in this world. Here's a team building activity that offers a rare opportunity to actually make a difference, with immediate, tangible results built into the process.

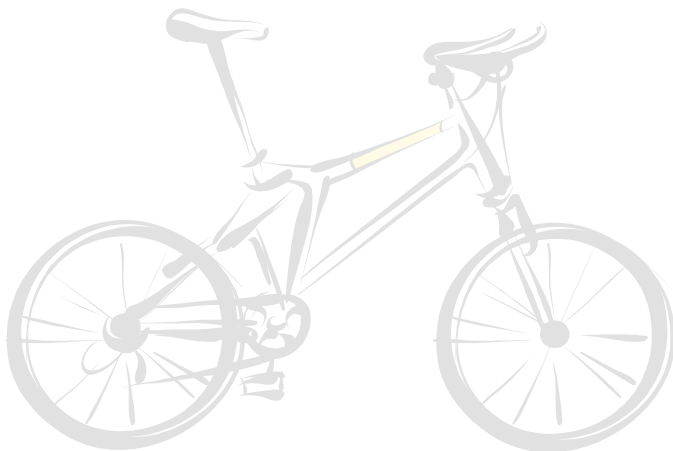

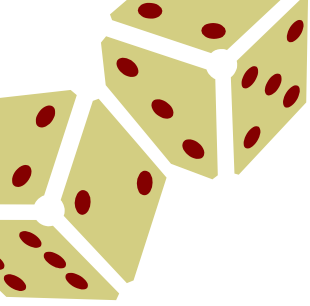

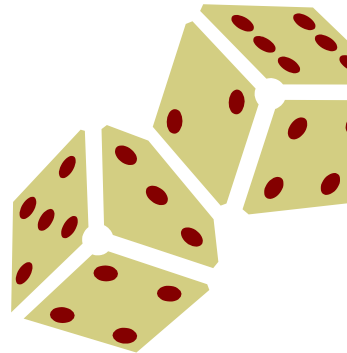
